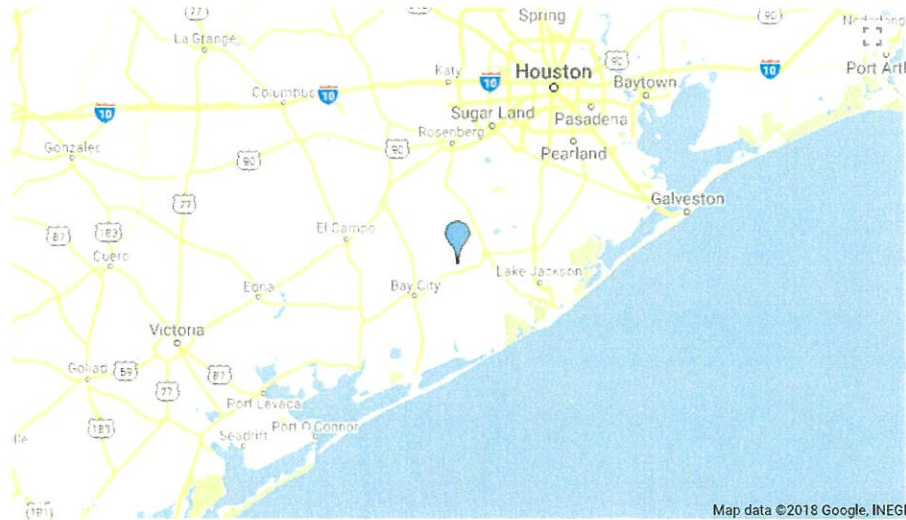


## Two Frio Gas Completions In Old Ocean North Field

### Description:

Plano, Texas-based Texakoma Exploration & Production has completed two Frio gas wells in Old Ocean North Field in Brazoria County (RRC Dist. 3), Texas. The #1 Dance Bayou flowed 3.383 MMcf of gas, 86 bbl of 47.7-degree-gravity crude and 31 bbl of water through perforations at 10,393-10,407 ft. The well is on a 135-acre upper Texas Coast lease in Section 32, Johnson & Walker & Borden Survey, A-77. Total depth is 10,544 ft. About 1.5 miles to the northeast, #3R Flag Pond was tested flowing 920 Mcf of gas and 15 bbl of condensate per day from perforations at 10,480-85 ft. It was drilled to 10,650 ft, 3,083 ft true vertical, in a sidetracked hole. The initial directional test was abandoned at 2,419 ft and is on a 640-acre lease in Section 33, Zeno Phillips Survey, A-118.

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
